The West Linn Lions Club is proud to present scholarships to outstanding 2024 seniors of West Linn High School (or an approved WLWV School District alternative program) interested in continuing their education at a university, community college and/or vocational-technical school.

West Linn Lions Club has been committed to serving our community since 1953. You may have seen our members selling Lion Burgers to support local fundraisers or cooking at the Old Time Fair. Our plastic recycling program keeps thousands of pounds of waste out of landfills and turns them into benches. The club has installed benches at the Library, Mary S Young Park, Bolton and Sunset Elementary Schools. The annual Wine Raffle funds our Scholarship program. We have awarded 105 scholarships totaling \$163,500 over the past 18 years. Our established endowment will soon provide permanent funding for scholarships.

Health Care and Planet Care - \$2500

For the student intending to pursue higher education in these broad categories: Natural Resources, Forestry, Environmental Health, Healthcare Occupations, Etc. (Think healthy individuals in a healthy environment - clean air, water, soil, food.)

For the student intending to pursue higher education in these broad categories: Journalism, Performing Arts, Web design, Graphic Art, Etc.

Overcoming Challenges - \$2500

For the student that had to work harder to achieve academic success- overcoming barriers such as health, sight hearing, reading, physical difficulties, memorization, concentration, family complications.

Community Service - \$3000

For the student who has made an impact through volunteer service to our community.
